In 2000, after releasing four albums, two of which won gold, and touring for six years, Wade Hayes decided to take a break. The plan was to write, rest and come back with fresh ideas. What he didn't expect was how tough it was to reclaim the attention of the people that mattered. However, his self-produced fifth album, *A Place To Turn Around*, made them turn their heads. Today, he showcases his strengths as a top-class vocalist, an incredibly talented guitar player and a writer of songs people can relate to. Nine of the eleven songs on the new CD were written by Wade.

Wayne enjoys a solid reputation as performer and songwriter. His signature #1 song "Old Enough To Know Better" and other top-10 hits blazed the trail for a remarkable music career. He offers his country music audience a distinctive heart-rendering baritone, well-written songs and outstanding musicianship. His music is neo-traditional.

They're hot! The group's mix of traditional country, southern country and country rock spruced up with a generous dose of honky tonk will set the audience ablaze. But it will not burn a hole into your festival budget.

Motherhood has not dimmed her zest for passionate and convincing performances giving the audience a taste of her special honky tonk style. Over the past few years Danni has successfully managed to build up a substantial following in Europe. Her frequent appearances even prompted her to set up residence in Spain for a while. Although now back in Nashville, she's ready to get on the next plane to meet and please her many fans in Europe.

Danni is as much poet as bewitching entertainer and sexy chanteuse. Add to that her songwriting skills, which she demonstrated as a cowriter with the Tracy Byrd hit "I Wanna Feel That Way Again", and you have a female artist who wins audiences over with her talent and authenticity. She can carry off contemporary country music with no trouble at all, but it is obvious that her heart is more at home with more traditional country numbers with fiddle and twang.



Ray Stephenson

It's just a question of time before Ray Stephenson will turn up in the Songwriters Hall of Fame ... as an inductee. His prowess as a songwriter is manifested in a score of songs of which many were adopted by superstars like Willie Nelson, Kenny Chesney, Kris Kristofferson, Merle Haggard and Guy Clark. Ray also honed his skills as a guitar player and performer working with his own band and opening up on tour for Tim McGraw and Kenny Chesney. So far, Ray has two albums to his credit and a third in the works. In 2010, Guy Clark, Kris Kristofferson and Kenny Chesney recorded "Hemingway's Whisky", one of his newest songs.

With a bachelor's degree in painting and sculpture, Ray found a great deal of inspiration in the people he met in Nashville and on stage, which led to a series of stunning portraits of music's living legends. His work with the brush has been featured at the Country Music Hall of Fame and other popular places in Nashville. His work with the pen is increasingly finding acclaim by his peers and the audience.
